

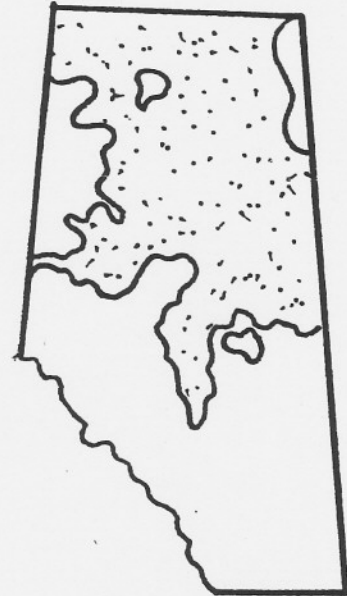
The Boreal Forest
